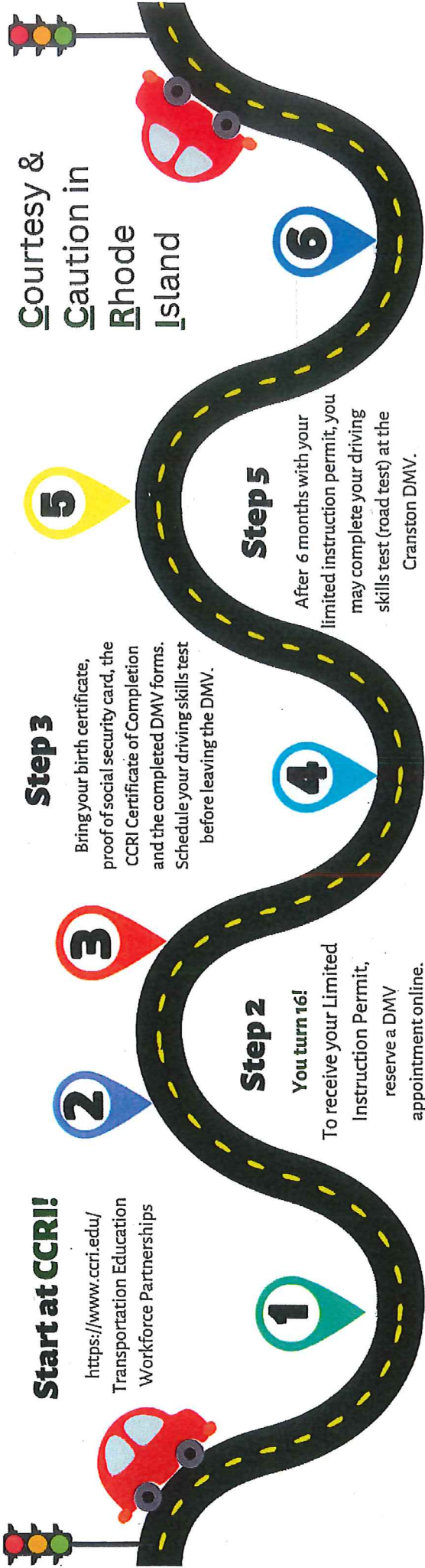




Graduated Driver License - Road Map To Get Your License

Step 1

Enroll in the mandatory 33-hour course. Students must be 15 years old and 10 months by the first day of class.

* CCRI course includes DMV Knowledge Exam.



Step 2

You turn 16!
To receive your Limited Instruction Permit, reserve a DMV appointment online. <https://dmv.ri.gov/>



Step 3

Bring your birth certificate, proof of social security card, the CCRI Certificate of Completion and the completed DMV forms. Schedule your driving skills test before leaving the DMV.



Step 4

You are almost there!
Complete and log 50 hours of behind-the-wheel instruction. Including 10 hours of night time driving.



Step 5

After 6 months with your limited instruction permit, you may complete your driving skills test (road test) at the Cranston DMV.



Step 6

Congratulations!

You are now a Rhode Island provisional licensed driver.

- No more than one non-household passenger under the age of 21.
- Cannot drive between the hours of 1:00 am - 5:00 am, by yourself.
- Must have a seatbelt properly fastened.
- Must be in possession of the license.
- You are required to hold a minimum of liability insurance.
- Follow R.I. Gen. Laws § 31-10-6
